Railways.

North Shore Railway.

There are two passenger trains daily between Quebec and Montreal, a lightning train leaving Montreal and Quebec, at 4 o'clock P. M., and a regular passenger train leaving Montreal and Quebee, at 9 o'clock A. M.

These connect at Montreal with western trains and the Grand Trunk, and arrive at Quebec

and at Montreal, at 3.30 and 9.30 P. M.

There is an accommodation train between Quebec and Three Rivers. This train leaves Quebec at 5 o'clock P. M., arriving at Three Rivers, at 10.15 P. M.

Returning it leaves Three Rivers, at 3.15 A. M., and arrives at Quebec at 8.40 A. M.

Sunday trains leave Quebec for Montreal, at 4 P. M.
