MONUMENT TO MRS. STOWE.

A monument has recently been erected on the grave of the authoress, Harriet Beecher Stowe, at Andover. It is a cross of Scotch granite twelve feet high, and is copied after one in the possession of the Duke of Argyle, which Mrs. Stowe greatly admired while visiting in Scotland. Upon the cross is the inscription, "Tribute to a loving remembrance, erected by the children," and lower down, "1811—Harriet Beecher Stowe—1896." Upon the white granite pedestal is the inscription, "Her children rise up and call her blessed." The grave is in the private cemetery of the trustees of Phillips Academy, and in the same lot are buried her husband and son.
