The private papers of Dr. O.D. Skelton are believed to be in private hands, although much of the official correspondence is scattered in Departmental files.

The note appended to the chapter on Loring C. Christie indicates that all his official papers were returned after his death to the Department, and after being sorted and indexed were broken up and separated into relevant Department subject-files.

Regarding the structure and organization of the Department during the period under review, use has been made of Departmental files and the annual Reports of the Department and of the Auditor General. A detailed review of its organization in 1931-33 is given in Gerald E.H. Palmer's <u>Consultation</u> and <u>Cooperation in the British Commonwealth</u> (1934) pages 32-41. This was brought up-to-date in the revision by Miss Heather Harvey, in <u>Consultation and Cooperation in the Commonwealth</u>, (1051), pages 179-186.
