

workcamps in the following countries: Austria, Belgium, Canada, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Egypt, Federal Republic of Germany, Finland, France, Great Britain, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Morocco, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey and the United States.

Age requirements

Participants must be at least 18 years of age for all countries except Federal Republic of Germany, France and Canada, which accepts 16 year olds. There is no maximum age.

Administration fee

A fee of \$85 for a workcamp is payable to CBIE at the time of application. Refunds will be made if CBIE has to cancel because placement of volunteers in one of the three countries of their choice cannot be made. A partial refund is made for early withdrawals.

Types of camps

Listed below are general descriptions of the types of camp according to work done:

- Construction and renovation; i.e., renovating heritage homes, restoring historic sites, turning an old store into a community centre;
- Manual work in parks or forests; construction of hiking paths; nature protection;
- Excavation and archaeological work;
- Work with children (activities, excursions);
- Work with people who are physically/mentally handicapped — (often in institutions); i.e., developing activities for patients, organizing outings, excursions;

- Other types of social work; and
- Work and study camps — manual and social camps; discussion on a given topic, i.e., alternate energy, apartheid, détente, alcohol, migrant workers, Third World development.
