Transportation and baggage arrangements by Army

Wednesday, May 25

1045 EDT Arrive at Uplands Airport (south side of cantilever hangar); greeted by officers of the Departments of External Affairs and National Defence and representatives of NATO missions

1100 Leave by bus for Dow's Lake landing stage (4 miles)

1120 Board sightseeing launch at Dow's Lake for Rideau Canal trip to head of locks by Chateau Laurier (30 minutes); trip courtesy of the City of Ottawa Tourist and Convention Bureau

1150 Arrive Chateau Laurier; proceed on foot to the East Block

1215 Meeting with Hon. D.B. Pearson, Minister of External Affairs

1245 Return to Chateau Laurier for lunch

1430 Leave hotel by Mackenzie Ave. entrance for bus trip via Sussex St. and Inter-Provincial Bridge for E.B. Eddy Co. lower paper mill, Laurier Ave., Hull

1445 Tour of E.B. Eddy plant

1545 Leave by bus for Chateau Laurier via Champlain Bridge, Island Park Drive, Experimental Farm, and Driveway, stopping briefly at Westgate Shopping Centre en route; dinner and rest of day free for private engagements such as meeting with representatives at NATO missions in Ottawa.

0900 Leave by bus from Mackenzie Ave. entrance of hotel for National Defence Headquarters, Army General Staff Conference Room, second floor, "A" Building, Elgin St. entrance

0915 Welcome by Hon. R.O. Campney, Minister of National Defence; briefing by General C. Foulkes, Chairman of Chiefs of Staff Committee; briefings on defence subjects

1030 Leave by bus for Langevin Block, Elgin St. entrance, Conference Room, Room 304.

1045 Welcome by the Hon. Jean Lesage, Minister of Northern Affairs and National Resources; briefing by Mr. Gordon Robertson, Deputy Minister, on Canadian North

1145 Leave by bus for No. 1 Temporary Building, Board Room, Room No. 140, second floor

1200 Meeting with Rt. Hon. C.D. Howe, Minister of Trade and Commerce

1230 Return to hotel by bus; lunch under private arrangements

1340 Leave hotel by bus, Mackenzie Ave. entrance, for Parliament Buildings
