In addition to this, since January 1925, I have spent the sum of \$1,322.30 in purchasing missing numbers of which \$1,045.45 was used for German publications. To make our files of these 47 German titles complete we would require approximately \$4,000 and a yearly increase of \$1,000.

As a matter of interest I have noted the titles of a few German periodicals with their respective prices for 1914 and 1926.
