The usual simple articles of homehold furniture, farming utensits, and mechanics' tools, etc. Also the homestead of every head of a family, to the value of \$500, provided ho has had a declaration and due notice of such intention signed, seated, and witnessed, and duy registered in the office of the Register of the County, and permanently resides on the homestead. The wildow of a housekeeper, and the children during their minority, are entitled to sil the benefits of the exemption.

TEXAS.

The law exempts from sale on execution, and en-titles the widow of decedent to 200 acres of land, or any town or elty lot, or lots, not to exceed in value \$2000, as the homestead of a family, household and \$2000, as the nomestead of a family, household and kitchen furniture, not to exceed in value \$200. At implements of husbandry, etc., etc. Ily a recent de-elsion of the Supreme Court, an unmarried man is entitled to the same exemption, except the 200 acres of land.
