

Baseball Working Up To Peace Parkdale 14 Technical 9 Bowling League Scores

WELSH AND WHITE FOUGHT TEN WHIRLWIND ROUNDS

Chicago Boxer Was Given a Draw With the Lightweight Champion in the Milwaukee Bout - White Finished Strong.

MILWAUKEE, Wis., Nov. 9.—Fredie Welsh of Wales, lightweight champion of the world, was held to a draw by Charlie White of Chicago in a fiercely fought, ten-round contest here tonight. Under the law a referee's decision could not be given, but it was the opinion of the newspaper experts that White evened up honors by his whirlwind finish.

"White opened a wound over the champion's left eye, and Welsh, partially blinded by a thin stream of blood, was forced to back away in the tenth and cover up to escape White's terrific rights and lefts to the head.

When they weighed at 3 o'clock the champion weighed 141, and White in fighting gear weighed 135.

The first round was lively, but ineffective. White landed a shade in the second and third rounds, landing a number of hard blows on Welsh and striving to put over his left hook, credited with being his knockout punch. White landed a good uppercut in the third and put right and left to the body, but followed by missing with three left hooks.

Welsh began to fight like a champion in the fourth, backing White into a corner and giving him a good landing, and in the fifth Welsh took another big lead, whaling White all around the ring and taking little punishment in return. The Chicago boy showed better in the sixth, but Welsh jarred White with lefts and took the round by a shade.

White came back strong in the seventh and the round was about even. Welsh deserved the credit by a shade, the boys missed many times. White out-fought Welsh in the eighth. They traded punches at the bell, and after a hard rally in the center of the ring the Chicago boy made the champion retreat and White drove Welsh into a corner and laced him with stinging rights and lefts to the body. White landed two rights on Welsh's jaw as the round ended.

White rubbed the fight in the tenth, again driving Welsh into a corner, where he landed five times without a return. White opened up a cut over Welsh's eye and peppered him with rights and lefts to the head. Welsh swung wildly, with blood trickling into his eyes. He was into a clinch, and as they broke White put two rights to Welsh's head and a right to his jaw. The last two rounds were White's all the way. White left the ring without a mark, while Welsh was bleeding profusely.

Varsity to Keep in Good Shape

Will Play an Exhibition Game With Hamilton R.C.—The Rugby Situation.

The Hamilton Rowing Club will play an exhibition game next Saturday with Varsity at the stadium to keep the two teams in shape for games they are likely to play a week later. Of course, Ottawa will pull for the final, having failed to see anything this year wherein a home team secured anything except a wallowing.

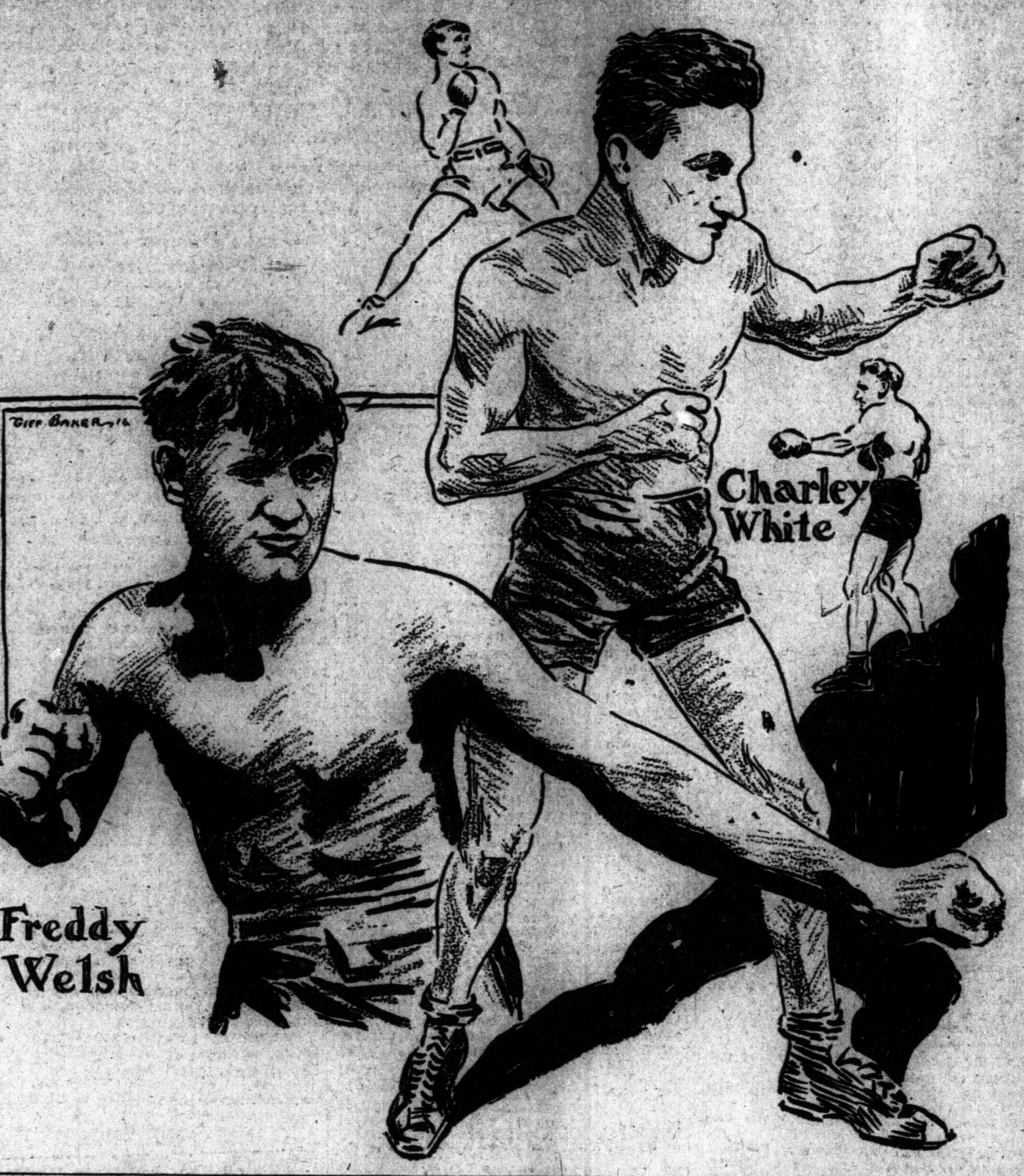
An Ottawa despatch says: Efforts are being made to have the intercollegiate championship between McGill and Varsity staged at Lansdowne Park on Nov. 21, if the anticipation of a saw-off pass out as expected. McGill and Varsity will seek neutral territory for their combat, and already the venue of this contest has narrowed down to Ottawa or Kingston, with the chances favoring the capital, where a gate of treble or four times the proportions that could be drawn in Kingston would be assured.

EVERYTHING FAVORS PEACE AT OMAHA

President Barrow Arrives Today—No Major League Rating for Federals.

OMAHA, Neb., Nov. 9.—The board of arbitration of the National Association of Professional Baseball Leagues carried on its business today without the presence of E. H. Barrow, president of the International League, who is one of the members of the board of adjustment.

President Barrow, who was due in Omaha this morning, stopped over in Chicago to hold a private conference with Ban Johnson, Garry Herrmann and representatives of the Federals. Johnson, Herrmann and Barrow will reach Omaha Tuesday morning, and the latter will once take up his work in the board of arbitration.

The sole representative of the International League now in Omaha is S. D. Flanagan of the Providence (Rhode Island) team. He has done additional work for the board of adjustment.

Members of that organization are expected here Tuesday, however, when the baseball men come in from Chicago.

Nearly 200 representatives of organized baseball are already here, and an additional 100 are now en route.

"I believe the troubles of the International League will be all smoothed out," said Flanagan. "It is in the air that the trouble between the majors and the Federals has been adjusted, and the announcement will probably be made here within forty-eight hours—possibly Tuesday. We don't know what the terms are, and we don't care, just so peace is declared."

"But the peace will not be a recognition of the Federals as a major league. The International League will be that one."

As soon as the full international delegation arrives tomorrow, the members will probably go into a caucus to decide the resolution which President Corish of the National Commission for the minor leagues has been adopted, and Mr. Flanagan could not commit the International League to a policy either for or against until he hears a conference with President Barrow and his colleagues tomorrow.

President J. P. Fitzgerald of the Canadian League, together with several other magnates from that organization, are attending the conference. The Canadian League is very much interested, as it expects the board of arbitration to recognize it as a Class A organization. This will probably be taken into consideration, as it is understood no protest is being made.

The arbitration board tonight announced that the Eastern Canadian League would be permitted to hold certain territory next year without placing teams therein.

GIVING UP THEIR RETAIL STORE

Semi-ready Store in This City to Be Closed Up.

One of the Directors States That the Present Shop Will Be Closed as Quickly as the Stock Can Be Disposed Of.

It has been decided to close the Semi-ready Store on Yonge street. The Semi-ready Company opened the store several years ago as a demonstration of the best salaried work they do, but there is a prejudice among the trade against the store, and the directors have decided to close up the store at 143 Yonge street as quickly as the stock can be disposed of.

The store at 143 Yonge street and the entire building, four stories in height, is to be offered for rent at once. The question of the Semi-ready franchise will not be considered in conjunction with the store, though a prospective tenant could have the first option of the lease for a franchise for Semi-ready tailoring.

"That the store will be closed as soon as the present stock has been disposed of has been definitely decided," said the vice-president of the company. "Mr. Hay, the manager of the store, has completed his work, and he is preparing to get rid of his \$100,000 stock of clothing and men's furnishings. It will be a sale absolutely and without reserve, and I have no doubt he will present the particulars forcibly."

"Mr. Hay is authorized to receive offers for the lease of the store and for the fixtures as well."

"It was not our intention," said the representative of the company, "to conduct a retail store direct, but we were compelled to meet an emergency when the trade objected to our fixed price in the pocket. Merchants claim that they could not do business on the close profit enforced by the price label in the pocket. But today we have proven up in every other town and city of consequence in Canada, and we are quite willing to retire from the retail trade in Toronto and co-operate direct with any wholesale customers who will appreciate the quality and the prestige of Semi-ready purpose to establish a chain of stores as has been charged against us by competitive manufacturers."

"Three floors—ground floor, second floor and basement—all devoted to the sale of the richest and finest wearing apparel for men—will be thrown open, and not a single garment or article will be excepted from the sale," said Mr. Hay. "Many of the articles will be sold for the mere cost of the material in them and not a single article will be sold for more than the wholesale price. That's how deep and how quick I am going to act," said Billy Hay.

It is not known whether the plan contemplates the trading of players to the Phillies or the outright purchase for cash, but there can be no doubt but that the negotiations for Doon are in Lauro, Md., and the representatives of the New York Club in the office here could neither confirm nor deny the report, not having heard from the Giant leader.

Doon admitted to a close personal friend two days ago that he had the offer for under advisement and expressed the belief that the deal would go through.

The Giants are badly in need of new players on account of the gradual slow-down of McLean and Meyers. The new man, Harry Smith, may or may not turn out as expected. At any rate, a catcher of the calibre of Doon can be used to advantage.

M'GILL TRIES TO EXPLAIN SITUATION

Paisley Tells Why He Would Not Toss the Coin With Charlie Gage.

Montreal Gazette: Following the victory of Varsity, Charlie Gage, who captains and manages the team, visited McGill headquarters on Saturday night and suggested to Captain Paisley of the McGill team that they toss for the choice of grounds for the play-off.

Paisley refused to entertain the proposition, stating that he had not the authority of the McGill club to take such action, and in the second place he pointed out that McGill had not the right to toss for grounds for a play-off until they defeated Queens on Saturday next.

Gage insisted that according to the following clause in the rules of competition Varsity and McGill were now tied one point. The club which has at the completion of the season's schedule a majority of points shall be entitled to the championship of the union.

Varsity are no doubt anxious to bring the intercollegiate to a finish, in hopes of their winning the honors, which would give them sufficient time to play a Dominion final. It is not likely that there will be a Dominion championship played for this season, as the existing tie in the intercollegiate and a probable tie in the interprovincial and Ontario Union will carry the season along too far for a Dominion final.

President J. M. Hallett of the Intercollegiate Union, who will be in Montreal Saturday to play with Queens against McGill, will likely call a meeting for that night, when the question of grounds will be decided should a tie exist. If Queens win the game the meeting will be canceled, and the championship will have been won by Varsity.
