

An Act to amend the Steamboat Inspection Act, 1898.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 5 **1.** Subsection 1 of section 3 of *The Steamboat Inspection Act*, 1898, is amended by striking out the first seven lines down to and including the word “Act” and substituting therefor the following words:—“No steam yacht used exclusively for pleasure or private use without hire or remuneration of any kind, and no steamboat having an engine under 10 five nominal horse power, shall be subject to the requirements of this Act.” 1898, c. 46, s. 3 amended.

- 15 **2.** Subsection 12 of section 33 of the said Act is amended by striking out the words “an applicant” in the third line thereof and substituting therefor the following words:—“any 15 fourth-class engineer.” Section 33 amended.

- 20 **3.** Subsection 1 of section 35 of the said Act is amended by striking out the words “or any freight steamboat of over one hundred and fifty tons gross” in the third and fourth lines thereof, and substituting therefor the following words:—“or 20 on any steamboat having an engine of more than five nominal horse power other than a steam yacht used exclusively for pleasure or private use without hire or remuneration of any kind.” Section 35 amended.
