[†] The annual meeting audits the accounts of the Trustees—whether the money received by them has been properly accounted for.—C. S. D. No. 32. But should the meeting terminate without notice of incorrect accounts, no action can be taken (except at a special meeting zealed by the Trustees for that purpose, should they agree to do so; or in a court of law,) until the next annual meeting. the next annual meeting.
