Pay Club
Bills.

ART. 32.—All members are to pay their bills, for every expense they incur in the Club, before they leave the house.

No gam-
bling.

ART. 33.—No game shall on any account, be played for money, except Whist, Ecarté, Piquet, and Pool; nor Dice used in the Club-House, except at Backgammon. No higher stake than quarter dollar points shall be played for at Whist, nor shall any bet exceed one dollar; the games of Ecarté, Piquet, and Pool to be played for limited stakes, the limits to be fixed by the Committee.

Smoking.

ART. 34.—No smoking shall be permitted in the Club-House, except in the rooms set apart for that purpose.

No dogs.

ART. 35.—No member is on any account to bring a dog into the Club-House.

Constitu-
tion may
be altered.

ART. 36.—Any article of this constitution may be altered, amended, or suspended for any length of time, by the consent of two-thirds of the members present at any meeting specially convened for that purpose; and provided such alteration, amendment or suspension, shall have been specified in the notice summoning such meeting, and that at such meeting twenty members at least be present.
