CARNEGIE'S PROPOSED GIFT

Plan Does Not Involve Establishment of University Buildings in Washington.

SCHEME NOT WORKED OUT YET

Expenses of Deserving Students in Line of Original Investigation Will Be Paid.

Washington, Dec. 10.—The proposed gift of \$10,000,000 by Mr. Andrew Carnegie for educational purposes was discussed at today's meeting of the Cabinet.

It is said that his proposition does not involve the establishment of university buildings in Washington, but the expenses of a fund in the hands of government trustees...

Hon. Carroll D. Wright, Commissioner of the United States Department of Education, made the following statement as to Mr. Carnegie's endowment of a National University at Washington...

"The general discussion which has been carried on during the last 25 years in relation to the establishment of a National University at Washington has culminated in a magnificent plan and endowment by Mr. Carnegie...

"I. Organization. A private foundation independent of government support or control."

"II. Objects. (a) To facilitate the use of the scientific and other resources of the government for research...

"Mr. Carnegie found that an institution devoted to research in the sciences and capable persons was more in accordance with his conceptions than the establishment of a university that would be a rival of the already existing universities of the country."
