KINGSTON CITIZENS UNITE TO BRING STRONG PRESSURE. Prominent Citizens Will Accompany Deputation, Urging Government to Act Favorably.

Kingston, Feb. 16.—(Staff Special.)—A feeling of general satisfaction was expressed by the citizens today at the decision of the city Council last night to send a deputation to the Ontario legislature to ask that the agreement between the city and the Street Railway Company should be amended by attaching a penalty clause as well as providing for the running of the cars, and for the privilege of purchasing the system from the company, if desired, by giving six months' notice.
