BERLIN, via London, May 15.—In one of the most vigorous and plain spoken speeches he has yet made before the Reichstag since the outbreak of war, the Imperial German chancellor today bluntly refused to enter into a discussion of Germany's peace aims, as demanded in interpellations by the Conservatives and Socialists. 


