THE NEEDLE JABBER STILL IS AT WORK

New York, Dec. 17—Four doctors who examined Miss Elizabeth Donnelly after she fainted on the steps of the Lincoln Hospital, the Bronx, are convinced that she was the victim of a real attempt at poisoning by needle jabbing, although no traces of any poison were

discovered.

If there was any poison in the instrument used by a well-dressed young man who followed Miss Donnelly on and off an elevated train and two trolley cars before accosting her, the fact that she had on a heavy chinchilla coat over her dress saved her from worse effects.

Whatever it was that the man used three pin-point pricks were made through the skin on the outer side of the right forearm above the wrist so that the wounds bled.

The pricks were an eighth of an inch apart, the three forming an obtuse triapart, the three forming an obtuse tri-angle and apparently made at one jab.
