MRS. MACKAY TO MAKE QUIT EUROPE TO MAKE HOME IN AMERICA. London, Eng. June 8.—Mrs. John W. Mackay, who during the thirty years of her continuous residence on this side of the Atlantic, has been famous as one of the most distinguished hostesses, is about to sever all connections with Europe. She has sold her magnificent home in Carlton House Terrace, where her husband, who was known as the "Bonanza King," died in 1902, leaving an estate of \$250,000,000. As a consequence of the death last year of her daughter, the Princess Colonna, Mrs. Mackay intends returning to America, where she will permanently make her home with her son, Clarence Mackay.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN MANITOBA

Winipeg, June 8.—Vocational training centers at which young men and women graduating from primary and high schools may receive thorough practical education in various branches of industry or home economics may be established in the near future by the Manitoba government. The government has decided not only to participate in the \$10,000,000 fund for technical education purposes provided recently by the federal government, but also to embark upon a vigorous course of action in this connection.
