Asks Court to Compel Board of Directors to Make Accounting of Huge Surplus -- Big Finan-

"That the defendants, and each of them, other than the defendant, the Equitable Life Assurance Society of the United States, account for their official conduct in the management and disposition of the funds and property committed to their charge charge.
"That the individual defendants, and

"That any defendant or defendants, now a director or directors or officer in the defendant society, upon proof of misconduct, be removed, and that a new election be held by the board of the defendant society, properly authorized to hold the same, in order to supply the vacancy or vacancies created by the removal.

"That the net surplus of the defendant society, after deducting a sufficient amount
