AGRICULTURE CONSULTANT STUDIES

Motion No. 235—Mr. Skoberg:

That an order of the House do issue for copies of all outside consultant studies undertaken for the Department of Agriculture as mentioned in answer to question No. 1,323, tabled on June 25, 1969, as reported in *Hansard* on page 10597.

Hon. Donald S. Macdonald (President of the Privy Council): Mr. Speaker, this motion and the succeeding 17 relate to the 1,184 remaining consultant studies. In the light of the decision which has just been taken, might we have agreement that these 18 motions be dropped?

Mr. John L. Skoberg (Moose Jaw): Mr. Speaker, this is a small price to pay for democracy, but in view of the time element today I agree to drop these motions and re-introduce them during the next session of parliament.

Mr. Speaker: Motions 235 to 262 inclusive are dropped.

Mr. Knowles (Winnipeg North Centre): Mr. Speaker, you just mentioned going as far as motion No. 262. Are there not some motions other than those of the hon. member for Moose Jaw which should be called, for example, 258, 259, 260 and 261? With respect, I think Your Honour went too far when you went to 262.
