SCHEDULE B.

REFERRED to in section 1 of this Act.

This Indenture made the sixth day of June, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, between the Ottawa, Arnprior and Parry Sound Railway Company, hereinafter called the Parry Sound Company, of the first part, and the Canada Atlantic Railway Company, hereinafter called the Atlantic Company, of the second part.

Whereas the Parry Sound Company have been duly incorporated by an Act of the Parliament of Canada, being chapter eight of the statutes of eighteen hundred and ninety-six, intituled "An Act amalgamating the Ottawa, Arnprior and Parry Sound Railway Company and the Parry Sound Colonisation Kailway Company, under the name of 'The Ottawa, Arnprior and Parry Sound Railway Company,'" and empowered to lay out, construct, complete, equip and operate a single or double line of railway, branches and side lines, as is therein mentioned and set forth, all of which will more fully appear, reference being had to the said Act and to the several Acts mentioned and set forth in the preamble thereto.
