tioned to try such appeal without any unnecessary delay, and to abide the judgment and to pay all costs to be awarded on such appeal.

DIVERS PROVISIONS.

- 16. The provisions of the Act, chapter one hundred and three of the Con. Stat. of Consolidated Statutes of Canada "respecting the duties of Justices of Canada to aport of the Peace out of Sessions in relation to summary convictions and ply to cases orders" in so far as the same are respectively applicable, shall extend and apply to cases under this Act.
- 17. All penalties and forfeitures recoverable under this Act and account to the Majesty, shall be paid to the Receiver General of this quor Inspection Fund."

- 18. With a view, to meet the expenditure to be incurred under the Even tavera provisions of this Act, it is enacted, that over and above the duties and over to pay one dollar fees now payable under the authority of any law, each and every tavern yearly to the keeper shall pay one dollar, which shall form part of the Liquor Inspectiquor Intion Fund, and which sum shall be payable to the Collector of Inland Revenue, and by him paid over, with other monies coming into his hands, to the Receiver General.
