Cut grass often but not too short Too many people fail to tribution to lawn care

realize that grass is a living plant. When they cut it, they take off "too much". The result is they destroy the leaf blade and can expose roots, particularly in summer, to

the full strength of the sun. The gardener who wants a good-looking lawn is involved in regular cutting of grass — never taking off too much at any one time. Obviously the regularity of cut depends on weather and soil conditions but the general principle of cutting grass every four or five days

In this latter situation, with regularity of cut, the cuttings are short and can be left on the lawn to be

assimilated as natural

nutriment. But associated with this technique is the type of mower used in this process A heavy mower, whether it has a grass catcher or not, can create a situation of "compacting" the soil and compressing cuttings, any problem of leaving creating a solid mat. Over a wheel-marks on a soggy period of time this can restrict growth and result in immediately after watering

Where no grass collection "dust-storm" is undertaken, the range of hover mowers now available on the market have abvious advantages. By floating on a cushion of air over the grass, they also create an air flow which swirls cuttings under the hood covering to create a fine mulch which is then dissipated over the lawn

area.
The fine mulch of grass cuttings is a form of natural "own blood" nutriment to the growing plant in contrast to the use of foreign stimulants.

At the same time, using grass cuttings as natural fertilizer brings time-saving advantages with no grass collection and the emptying of grass boxes. This activity can, in some circumstance occupy as much as one-third of normal grass cutting operations. Invariably, a grass catcher becomes full when the mower is at the furthermost point from the

compost heap.

The primary use of grass cuttings as own fertilizer for a lawn obviously limits additions to a compost heap. But there are, no doubt, few gardeners who have a shortage of compost potential in the average garden. In fact, the reverse is often the case.

While the hover mower technique of grass-cutting has obvious advantages in avoiding dangers of com-paction, it also has many other attractive features. For a start, the machine can be moved forwards; sideways; backwards. It is

Raking several times a year and at least one spell of proper spiking of the lawn area for aeration, are sound basic principles to apply to avoid thatching. Little has so far been written about the problems

of "compaction" or "that-ching" but greater interest is being shown by gardening specialists and in overall analysis there is general agreement the "thatching" is the lesser of the two evils and can be more easily overcome with less effort on gardener. With "com-paction", prevention is far easier than cure.
