


With further reference to the correspondence relating to the new plans of your right of way through the Pasqua Indian reserve, I have to inform you that these plans have been approved in so far as they affect the unsurrendered portion of the reserve. The title to the surrendered portion has passed from the Crown to the purchaser.

The tie of 391.2 feet, about which there was a slight ambiguity on account of the intervening post shown on the easterly limit of your right of way, has been accepted as being from the N.E. corner of Sec. 24 to the centre line, as stated in your letter of the 23rd ultimo and so indicated by arrows.

I am mailing all plans to you under separate cover this date. It is presumed that the Departmental copy will be returned by you at a later date.
