

(6) Unhealthy & polluted water in thickly populated centres is injurious to life & health.

The Chicago River is in a filthy condition, & often gives forth a bad odor.

The law prohibits improper substances to be deposited in it (1894) but that this law is not observed or enforced the condition of the river shows for itself.

(7) Overcrowding is often most injurious to life, health & morals.

The sweating system whereby an outside person might be brought to work in the house, has ^{was} ~~been~~ forbidden by law, ^{in 1893} but the members of the family are still permitted to work in their kitchens & bedrooms.

In tailoring & cigar making the sweating is still carried on to some extent.

There are at least 26,000 tenement house shops in Chicago at present.

The law ^{has not} ~~does not~~ make provision prohibiting these tenement house shops, if used only by members of one family.

(8) Obnoxious odors are often injurious to health & life.

They are prevalent in many quarters esp. ^{Polk st.}

The law in some degree tries to prevent their existence, but the fact they are present shows that law will not suffice.
