

the school returns. When a pupil enters the school he should be given a register number, which number he should retain during the entire period he is in the school. It is noticed on the return that the Principal has given the same register number to different pupils. This leads to confusion and creates difficulty in the checking of these returns. He should see that all the columns as called for in the returns are properly filled in in the case of each of the pupils.
