Registration of Trap-lines

I am in receipt of your letter of 14th inst. advising of notification received from Indian Agent Harper Reed that the trapping ground registered in the name of Roy and Mike Pat McCluskey is not being trapped, and that same should be cancelled as there is very little likelihood of these Indians trapping this ground.

It is also noted that Mr. Reed states that Mr. McCluskey and his boys wish to take over the ground registered in favor of the above. This would appear to be a matter of cancellation and transfer, and we would appreciate your advising Mr. Reed that in routine matters of this nature he should make the necessary arrangements for cancellation and transfer through Inspector T. Van Dyk of the Game Department at Prince George.

From the records in this office there would appear to be no reason why the cancellation and transfer mentioned should not be put into effect, and we would appreciate your having Mr. Indian Agent Harper Reed take the necessary steps in this connection, through Inspector Van Dyk.
