such reserve appeared in the official schedule. He recommended that this reserve be included and regularly constituted as an Indian Reserve. The witness also directed attention to the fact that Indian Reserve No. 5 appeared in the schedule as a Reserve of the Village Island Band, although it should have been set forth as belonging to the Brickeltoneous; it had always been recognized as belonging to the Brickstonesses and occupied and used by them; there was no dispute among the Indians about it; it was simply wrong in the schodule (Note: See minutes of deciden in this matter). This place was used all the time as a fishing station. Applications B2 and B5, for Wals-hanes and Dil-ties. were not recommended; with respect to M4. Gwast, the application was recommended, as the land asked for would never be of any particular use to anyone but the Indiana. There was an old mill site on the Timber Limit there and the place applied for the only practicable landing beach in the neighborhood. The Indians might have the land fronting from Timber Limit No. 15682 to the head of the Bay, and 20 chains deep -- from the northern boundary of Timber Limit No. 15682, the eld mill site. As to Application 85, it was recommended that Meetup Reserve No. 2 be confirmed to the Bricketteness Tribe, instead of to the Wilage Island Tribe, but that no addition be made there to, as the contiguous land had all been alienated, Application 36 (Tibia) was not recommended. As to E7 for Leakns or Likks (the Birdwool eroup of inlands), it was recommended that the westermost island of the Birdwood group, including the village site and containing about fifty cores, be granted. This would cover also Application IB, Brite. Application IO (Breburkwedi) want not recommended, as the landsapplied for were found to be elienated. As to No. 210 (Aprigiya), it was recommended that five agree be get saids there for the Mahamhillimlishs and that would be sufficient for all, as the place was wanted
