

Flour.—Receipts 87½ bbls., 500 bbls. last week, and 1,725 bbls. for the corresponding week of last year. There is little demand for any grade. Old ground superfine has soured to a considerable extent owing to the long continued heat. Fresh ground is worth \$3.50 to \$3.60, and a lot of 100 bbls. fine inspected, sold at \$3.25. **Outmeal.**—Is dull and nominal at quotations.

Provisions.—Butter—enquired for at 13½c for good tub. Cheese—nominal, at 9 to 9½c. Pork—Heavy mess is held at \$24, with buyers in small lots at \$23; thin mess sold at \$21.50. Bacon—A lot of 15 tons, Cumberland and ordinary, sold at 10½c. Eggs—Stock very light; receipts light.

Livestock.—Market dull and lower at \$4 to \$6 for cattle per 100 lbs. dressed weight; sheep \$3 to \$4 each; lambs \$1.50 to \$3.
