Proviso.

IX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that there shall to cover the amount of all contingent expenses and necessary disbursements of every kind as well as to defray the necessary expenses of superintendence, management or direction of any of the aforesaid works or improvements not included in any contract relating thereto, be allowed a sum or rate not exceeding seven and a half per cent, on the amount of all advances or payments upon the contracts to be made and entered into, under this Act: Provided always, that such allowance shall in no wise affect nor be taken from the money payable to any contractor or contractors as aforesaid, and that the same shall be paid only at the times that the payments are to be made, by Warrant, upon Certificates of the Commissioners as herein directed.

X. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that in case the Commissioners shall not comply with the provisions and requirements of this Act, they shall be held responsible in their private capacity for all losses or damages which the public may incur or sustain by reason of their neglect or mismanagement.

XI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that due the application of the said monies pursuant to the directions of this Act, shall be accounted for to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the time being, in such manner and form as His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors shall direct.
