RESOLVED, That an Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor in Chief, to return him the thanks of this House for his Message of this day, respecting the Proceedings of the Vaccine Institution; and to assure His Excellency that any Bill which this House may receive, appropriating a larger sum of money for the purposes of this Institution, shall receive their immediate consideration.

ORDERED, That the Honorable Messrs. *Hale* and *Ryland* do wait on His Excellency the Governor in Chief with the said Address.

Another Message was presented from His Excellency the Governor in Chief, by the Honorable Mr. *Ryland*.

The Members rose, and the Message was read in the words following:

The Governor in Chief informs the Legislative Council, that on a representation made to him during the last Summer, of the absolute and immediate necessity of repairs being made to the roof of the Bishop's Palace, over the apartments occupied by the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, he authorized an expenditure to be made for that purpose, under the direction of the Clerk of the Legislative Council, and the Clerk of the House of Assembly to the amount of five hundred and seven pounds; a statement of which he has caused to be laid before the Legislative Council herewith; and trusts that they will concur in making provision for covering the amount of the same.
