From such laudable Deportment, unseduced by the Example of those who have been missled, I am consident that the Royal Approbation, so gracifully express'd, will surther animate you to a steady Perseverance in Duty to your Sovereign, and in Attachment and Respect to the Mother Country.

'And I have further to acquaint you, from Authority, that among other Matters beneficial to this Colony, the Emission of a Paper Currency was fpeedily to come under Consideration.

'In Your Deliberations during this Session I parti-'cularly recommend to you a Revision of the Laws for 'collecting the Revenues; so that, in the Application of them, the Intention of the Legislature may not re-'main under any Doubt.

'I am persuaded, Gentlemen, that I need not urge Dispatch of the public Business to you. The present Season of the Year requires it, that you may attend to your Affairs in the Country; where I cannot too earnessly press your Application to Agriculture; and especially to the Culture of Hemp and Wheat, which I am particularly instructed to recommend to you, and may prove greatly beneficial to yourselves and to the Mother Country.

'You may be affured I will readily adopt and concur in every Measure of Utility you shall propose; and that my best Endeavours shall be exerted, to promote the Happiness of Individuals, and to establish the Welfare and Prosperity of the Whole.
