Fredericton, Thursday, 19th October, 1854.

**H**IS Excellency Sir Edmund Walker Head, Baronet, late Lieutenant Governor, having, by Proclamation bearing date the nineteenth day of May last, been pleased to dissolve the late General Assembly, and to order that new Writs issue for electing Members to form a House of Assembly; and also by further Proclamation, to prorogue the General Assembly to the seventeenth day of October instant;—His Excellency The Honorable John Henry Thomas Manners Sutton, the now Lieutenant Governor, having, by Proclamation bearing date the seventh day of the same month, been pleased further to prorogue the said General Assembly, and then and thereby summon a meeting of the said Assembly to be holden on this day for the dispatch of business—

The Clerk of the Crown in Chancery delivered to the Clerk of the Assembly a Roll containing the names of the Members returned by the Sheriffs of the several Counties as duly elected, and which is as follows:—
