

The Tory Tactics of 1909 Being Revived.

Piccott's Supporters try to stop F. P. U. Parade and got worsted--1000 People attend Meeting--Coaker Speaks for Two Hours and is Loudly Cheered.

BAY ROBERTS, To-day. 700 entered with me yesterday. Piccott's gang tried to prevent parade proceeding through harbor. About twenty-five in the drunken mob. Our forces overpowered Piccotts and proceeded on parade and returned through town. No one seriously injured. At our meeting quarter of the audience were Piccotts of the one thousand present. They tried to prevent me speaking but I got them to consent. They gave me splendid hearing during my address which lasted two hours. Wonderful excitement. Tremendous cheers for us with weak counter cheers for Piccott. They agreed to allow me to speak as long as I wished. When I closed Lloyd spoke for fifteen minutes being continually interrupted by about twenty hooligans. Started Branch against wish of Piccotts, but they afterwards subsided. One hundred and fifteen joined Union. Union Jack was torn down and trampled upon by the drunken mobbers during procession. It converted hundreds to us who rushed to join. Leaving by train for Carbonear and Western Bay.

BAY ROBERTS, To-day. The meeting last night was announced for eight o'clock, but by 7 the hall was filled. Lloyd, who did not know this, arrived at 8 and found a crowd outside who could not get in. They were going away. Outside the door there was a packed crowd, the porch packed with people and the hall packed.

WASHINGTON, To-day. The preparation of the State Department's answer to the British protest against the exemption of American coastwise shipping from tolls through Panama Canal is advancing rapidly. Following the precedent established by Sir Edward Grey, requiring that the British Ambassador in Washington read the protest to Sec. Knox, said absolutely pertinent, and established by mutual agreement certain facts as the basis either for adjustment of the issue directly between the two countries or for drafting an arbitration agreement under the terms existing already with Britain, which would carry the controversy to the Hague Tribunal. In either case he felt that the State Department had escaped the charge of having purposely delayed negotiations, for the work accomplished will be a substantial benefit to the incoming administration in dealing with the case.

LONDON, To-day. The next move in the game of diplomacy for the settlement of the war in Southeastern Europe is for Turkey to make a collective note of European Powers, drawn up by Ambassadorial Conference at London and handed to Turkish Government yesterday at Constantinople. Expectation among diplomats here is that Turkey will decline to have the Powers make efforts to bring peace delegates together again for further negotiations. Should this be the case, then will develop whether ultimatum of allies is as iron-clad as they profess to be. Meetings of the Ambassadors of foreign Powers continue to be held. The question of Turkish Islands has been set aside until the Ottoman Government answers note of Powers and Albanian affairs which are now under discussion.

WASHINGTON, To-day. The State Department here expressed disturbance over what they fear may result in a disastrous commercial war between Argentine and the United States. They have had reports to the effect that Argentine is likely to retaliate against the States for a view believed to be unfair commercial advantage taken of it by this country. Brazil grants to the States special preferential import of wheat and flour which allows this country to compete successfully with Argentina in that field. State Department have been informed that this is being looked upon as unfriendly, there is scarcely suppressed sentiment in the Argentine Congress which it is said may break out at any time in favour of a retaliatory action; furthermore the State Department have been informed that Argentine may withdraw from the Pan-American Union at the time of the next Pan-American Conference, unless condition change. This it was said probably would deal the coup to the Pan-American Union.

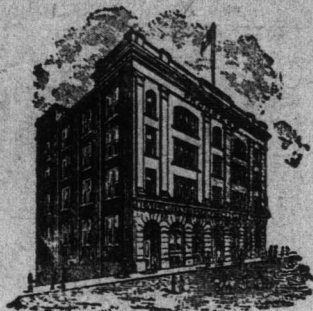

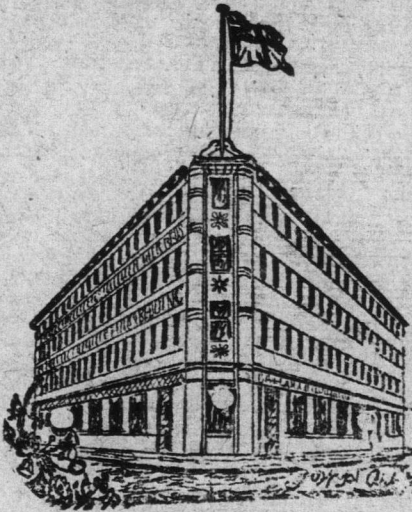
