Bed Rooms, Dormitories, Sanatorium, Baths—hot and cold—and all other appurtenances of a College. The private rooms accommodate three pupils, and the dormitories, eight.

The whole premises have been expressly planned and arranged, so as to secure every possible facility for the Educational and Domestic requirements of the pupils. The Ventilation, Heating, and Drainage are on the most modern and approved plans.

Divine Service is held in St Anne's Chapel, situated in the College grounds.

The object of this institution, as contemplated by its Founder, is to provide a thorough, liberal and useful education for young ladies, adapted to their wants in life, and based upon the soundest Protestant Christian Principles, as the only solid basis for the right formation of character.

No pains nor means have been spared to afford the very highest and best education in every branch.

The Discipline of the College, its Domestic, Social and Educational Departments, are under the most careful supervision.

Everything is done to make the College an attractive Christian home, and the material provision for the health and comfort of the pupils is perfect.

French is the Language Spoken in the College, and a French service is held in the Chapel every Sunday Afternoon, by a French Clergyman of the Church of England.
