

Bousebold Hints.

Snowflake Cares.—Half a cup each butter end lard, two cups powdered sugar, one cup milk, whites of five eggs and three cups flour. Flavour with vanilla and bake cups floor. in small tins.

PULLED BREAD.—Take a loaf of freshly made bread, and while it is still warm pull the inside out of it, in pieces the size of your hand. Put these in the oven and bake them a delicate brown.

FRITIERS.—Four eggs well beaten, one quart of flour, two teaspoons of baking powder, a half teaspoon of salt, milk enough to make a batter, fry in hot lard, sprinkle with sugar or eat with syrup.

WAFFLES.—One pint of sweet milk, two eggs, one pint of flour, one-half cup of butbutter, one teaspoonful of cream of tartar, one-half teaspoonful of sodz, a pinch of salt. Bake in waffle irons, well heated.

GINGER POUND CAKE .- Three cups of flour, one cup of molasses, one cup of butter-milk, one-half cup of butter, two teaspoonfuls of saleratus, two teaspoonfuls of cinnamon, one teaspoonful of ginger and two eggs.

APPLE JELLY.—Use good sour apples, elice them, skins, seeds and all, and sinmer with o 'alf a cup of water till well cooked and soft; then strain through a cloth, add a pound of sugar to a pint of juice, boil a few minutes, skinming till clear; pour into glasses and cover when cold.

SEVENCER PUDDING.—One-half cup of molasses, half-cup of milk, half-cup of raisins, seeded and cut in halves, half-cup of currants, half-cup of suet powdered, half-cup of graham flour, spice and salted to taste. Boil or steam for two and a half hours.

GRAHAM BREAD. - Take twice as much graham as white flour, two teacupfuls of the former and one each of white flour, sour milk and molasses, or less of the latter if not liked pretty sweet, and one teaspoonful each of salt and soda. Mix well; pour the mixture into a butter pan and steam two hours.

FRUIT PIES.- These are made in pie dishes, the top of which is only covered with paste; the edge of the dish should be wetted, and a strip of paste, about one inch wide and a quarter of an inch thick, put on it; then fill the dish with the fruit, wet the paste on the edge, and cover with paste; mark the edge with a roller, or the back of a knife.
