Government Land

Farming Lanus Any person who is the head of a family, or a single person 21 years old, a citizen, may take up 160 acres of land and acquire title by living on it and cultivating it for five years, or he may perfect title after fourteen month's settlement, residence and cultivation by paying \$1 25 per acre, or \$2.50 per acre when the land is within the limits of a rail oad grant. There are land office fees of about \$20.

Timber Land covered with valuable timber, and unfit for cultivation, can be purchased by any citizen or a sociation to the extent of 160 acres at a cost of \$2 50 per acre.

Can be taken upon the same terms as timber lands. Granite, sand-stone, limestone, etc., at many Stone Lands points along the Great Northern.

Coal Any person can acquire title to 160 acres by paying \$20 per acre if within 15 miles of a railway or Lands \$10 per acre it beyond that limit. An association or company of persons can secure 320 acres under same terms.

Mineral Mining claims upon veins or Lands lodes of precious metals can be taken up along the veins to the length of 1,500 feet and 300 feet each side of the middle of the vein.
