A roofing contractor in order to secure this Surety Bond for the owner must be satisfactory to us and must construct the roof *under the supervision of one of our inspectors.*

This insures good workmanship, the proper amount of waterproofing materials, and will

result in a roof that will last far longer than the guaranteed period.

We now give this bond on all roofs of fifty squares or over in all towns of 25,000 population and over, and in smaller places where our Inspection Service is available, the only provision being that The Barrett Specification dated May 1, 1916, shall be strictly followed.

If you want a roof that will last for twenty years or over, give your architect or roofing contractor a copy of The Barrett Specification dated May 1, 1916, and tell him to lay such a roof and secure for you a 20-Year Surety Bond. Then your building will be covered with the best and most economical roof it is possible to lay.
