

CTC : It has a concession of indefinite length for its service and operates with its own means and through the means of other carriers.

2.2.4. Other services

Other services include:

Cellular Telephones:

Four companies participate in this service and for this purpose Chile has been theoretically divided into two geographical areas. At present the admission to the 800 MHz frequency is limited, since only two companies at the most may exist or co-exist by area in this system. In the future, additional concessions may be requested in 400 MHz, and additional companies may be accepted, but at present in Chile for Cellular Telephony only the 800 MHz frequency is used.

In the Metropolitan Region and in the V Region operate CTC and Cidcom with indefinitely timed concessions. In the rest of the country, there is Cellular Telephony of Chile (Telefonía Celular de Chile) a branch of VTR; and Telecom, both of them with indefinitely timed concessions.

Beepers or Paging Systems:

For Beepers or pagers there are various companies operating in various regions of the country: Santiago, Concepción and V Region are completely saturated and there is no additional concession available. In Temuco, in the South there is still room for one additional concession. All concessions have the character of indefinite length.

In the Metropolitan Region participating companies are:
