Mad City exposes the worst of broadcast journalism: the pack mentality, the hounding of crime victims, the flerce competition for "hot" news events, the cynicism of youthful network executives, the egomanized anchor persons.

It all starts because a dim-witted museum quard (John Travolta) has been laid off. He is so desperate to regain his job and support his wife and two children that he enters the museum with a rifle and a bag of dynamite. At first, he merely pleads with the museum boss, Blythe Danner, to be rehired.

Dustin Hoffman, a defrocked network reporter reduced to field work at a TV station in a mediumsized California city, happens to arrive at the museum to cover a humdrum story.
