MR. LEHTINEN WAS BORN AT MUURLA, FINLAND, ON OCTOBER 10, 1896. HE IS A GRADUATE OF UNIVERSITY OF HELSINKI AND ENTERED THE DIPLOMATIC SERVICE IN 1948. MR. LEHTINEN HAS SERVED AS COMMERCIAL ATTACHE AT THE FINNISH LEGATION IN WASHINGTON, DIRECTOR OF COMMERCIAL AFFAIRS AT THE MINISTRY FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS, CONSUL GENERAL OF FINLAND IN NEW YORK, PERMANENT OBSERVER OF FINLAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS AND, HAS BEEN CHARGE D'AFFAIRES OF THE LEGATION OF FINLAND IN OTTAWA SINCE 1959.
