PRAYERS.

Three Petitions were laid on the Table.

The Clerk of the House laid upon the Table the Fourth Report of the Clerk of Petitions, stating that he had examined the following petitions presented on the 1st instant, and finds that all the requirements of Standing Order 68 have been complied with in each case, namely:—

Of The Dominion Association of Chartered Accountants, praying for the passing of an Act to amend its Act of incorporation.—*Mr. Plaxton.*

Of Revillon Freres Trading Company, Limited, praying for the passing of an Act to change its name to Rupert's Land Trading Company, and otherwise to amend its Act of incorporation.—*Mr. Maybank.*

Mr. Dunning, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Governor General,—The Public Accounts of Canada, for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1937.

Mr. Esling, seconded by Mr. Church, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. 12, An Act to amend The Copyright Amendment Act, 1931, which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Brunelle, seconded by Mr. Patterson, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. 13, An Act to amend the Lord's Day Act, which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.
