

(6) Where paragraph (4)(c) applies, the Minister shall reduce the manufacture reference weighted aggregate quantity for the manufacture of chlorofluorocarbon of the person referred to in that paragraph by the amount by which that person agreed to have his manufacture reference weighted aggregate quantity reduced.

(7) Where the Minister believes that the manufacture during a control period of chlorofluorocarbon for use in Canada by a person described in subsection (1) will result in Canada exceeding the calculated level of consumption allowed for Canada under the terms of the Protocol, the Minister may reduce the manufacture reference weighted aggregate quantity for the manufacture of chlorofluorocarbon by that person during that period by an amount equivalent to the amount of the resulting excess.

#### Importation of Chlorofluorocarbon

5.(1) No person shall import chlorofluorocarbon in bulk into Canada except in compliance with these Regulations.

(2) Effective January 1, 1990 no person shall import chlorofluorocarbon in bulk from any country that is not a Party to the Protocol.

6.(1) A person who imported chlorofluorocarbon into Canada in bulk in the calendar year 1986 or to whom an import reference weighted aggregate quantity has been assigned under subsection (4) may import chlorofluorocarbon into Canada during a control period in a quantity or quantities that will not result in the weighted aggregate quantity of chlorofluorocarbon imported in bulk by that person exceeding the import reference weighted aggregate quantity for the import of chlorofluorocarbon by that person during the control period.

(2) For the purpose of subsection (1), the import reference weighted aggregate quantity for a person who imported chlorofluorocarbon in bulk into Canada in the calendar year 1986 is

(a) for any control period commencing in the calendar years 1989 to 1992, the sum of the products obtained by multiplying the number of tonnes of each chlorofluorocarbon imported in bulk by that person in the calendar year 1986 by the ozone-depleting potential of that chlorofluorocarbon set out in Schedule I,

(b) for any control period commencing in the calendar years 1993 to no later than 1997, 80 percent of the quantity calculated pursuant to paragraph (a)2 and
