That a sum not exceeding

\$10,458,957,258.08 being composed of:

(1) three-twelfths (\$7,830,304,719.75) of the total of the amounts of the items set forth in the Main Estimates for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1988, which were laid upon the Table Monday, March 2, 1987, except those items below:

(2) eleventh-twelfths of the total of the amounts of Agriculture Item 60, Transport Items 15 and 20 and Treasury Board Item 10 (Schedule A) of the said Estimates, \$193,214,083.33.

(3) nine-twelfths of the total of the amount of Treasury Board Item 5 (Schedule B) of the said Estimates, \$270,000,000.00.

(4) seven-twelfths of the total of the amounts of Energy, Mines and Resources Item 35 and Public Works Item 20 (Schedule C) of the said Estimates, \$61,409,833.33.

(5) six-twelfths of the total of the amounts of Regional Industrial Expansion Item 15 and Transport Item 30 (Schedule D) of the said Estimates, \$2,099,000.00.

(6) five-twelfths of the total of the amounts of Communications Item 80 and Indian Affairs and Northern Development Item 15 and National Health and Welfare Item 55 and Transport Item 35 (Schedule E) of the said Estimates, \$701,948,625.00.

(7) four-twelfths of the total of the amounts of Communications Items 30 and 70, Consumer and Corporate Affairs Items 1 and 25, Environment Item 1, Indian Affairs and Northern Development Items 10, 35, 40 and 45, Labour Item 1, National Health and Welfare Item 10, Regional Industrial Expansion Item 40, Science and Technology Item 1, Supply and Services Item 1, Transport Item 1, Treasury Board Item 30 and Veterans Affairs Items 5 and 25 (Schedule F) of the said Estimates, \$1,399,980,996.67;

be granted to Her Majesty on account of the fiscal year ending March 31, 1988.
