passes through the two narrow channels, on each fide of Hoolaiva, where it runs with confiderable rapidity, and then fpends itself in the *lagoon*. The ebb returns the same way, and runs with rather greater force. The North West tide is met, at the entrance of the *lagoon*, by one from the East; but this, as I have before observed, was found to be very inconfiderable.
