 To Wit:) **BY GIVEN** to the Electors
 of the County of Renfrew, That in obedience to Her
 Majesty's Writ, to me directed, and bearing date the
 Twenty-Seventh day of the month of February, 1856,
 I require the presence of the said electors, at or near the
 dwelling-house of Xavier Plante, in the village of Ren-
 frew, in the Township of Horton, in the said County of
 Renfrew, on the Eighteenth day of the month of March,
 A. D. 1856, at One of the clock in the afternoon, for the
 purpose of *Electing* a person to represent them in the
 Legislative Assembly of this Province, and that in case a
 Poll shall be demanded and allowed in the manner by
 Law prescribed, such Poll shall be opened on the *Twen-*
ty-Seventh day of the month of March, 1856, in the
 Townships of McNab, Horton, Ross, Westmeath, Pem-
 broke, Admaston, and Bromley, the united townships of
 Bagot, Blythfield and Brougham, Wilberforce, Grattan
 and Fraser, and Stafford and Alice.

Of all which every person is hereby required to take
 notice and to govern himself accordingly.
