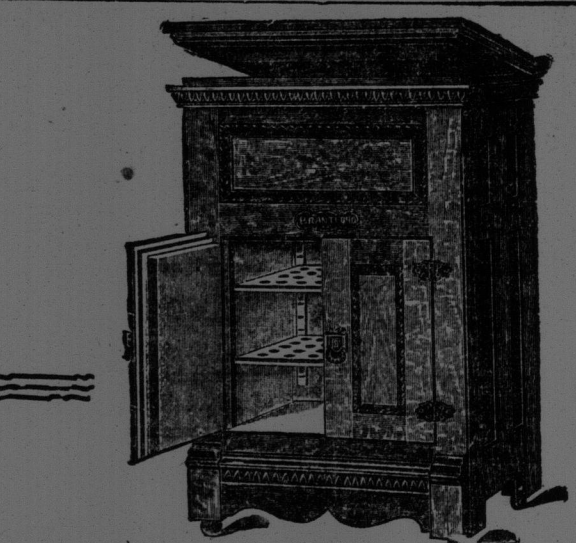
would go to Portland to load grain and general cargoes for Europe, and that a number of steamers will come with sulphur from Texas.

#### SURPASSING MUSICAL PROGRAMME MARKS THE IMPERIAL BILL

Specialty Delightful Vocal and Violin Numbers Besides Good Pictures

The Imperial Theatre gave considerably more than the usual dinner's worth in good music alone yesterday, particularly in the evening when, with its eleven orchestra players and two acts of concert, it presented a programme for which St. John people have often given a good half dollar to hear. The programme was a most excellent one, and the Imperial Theatre, which has made her how to this community. Comparisons are usually considered odious, but it would be unfair to the newcomer if her art were placed on a lower plane than that of her several predecessors on the Imperial stage. #### REFORMATORY FOR WOMEN MUCH NEEDED IN MAINE

(Madison, Me. Bulletin)  
A local judge deprecates Maine's lack of a reformatory institution for women, says an exchange. Thursday, he was obliged to send two girls to jail for 90 days each because he had no other recourse—they could not be sent to the Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell.

Billy Sunday said: "The little slave in short skirts today knows more of sin and devilment than her grandmother does."  
That is the type-units of humanity started in filthy places—many of them—and watered by a pool of booze, nourished mentally by the sheddings of the tree of cussedness round about, and abominating from infancy the misconception that humanity is all alike and those who are apparently innocent have merely escaped detection. The streets of all cities are more or less encumbered with those sadly deficient specimens, hiding for male attention and assignation. Community officials and courts struggle with

It is not the place for these victims of social malformation. It is not the punishment, but wholesome enlightenment that they and the community need, yet, as in the case of these two girls, quite probably the victims of home or environment gone wrong, they must go to jail to protect others, or, so-called, to pursue more bravely and defiantly than ever, their misdirected course.
