

PROSPECTUS OF THE PETIT SEMINAIRE
OF
STE-MARIE DE MONNOIR.

The *Petit Séminaire de Ste Marie de Monnoir* was founded in the year 1853, by the late Very Rev. Edward Crevier, Vicar General, with the view of preparing young men, not only for the church and the high callings of civil life, but also for commercial and industrial pursuits. Hence the course of studies, in which religious instruction keeps the first rank, is divided into two sections, viz: The COMMERCIAL COURSE and the CLASSICAL COURSE.

The COMMERCIAL COURSE consists of three years. It includes the study of the French and English Languages, Mathematics, Book-Keeping, History, Epistolary Art, etc., etc., in a word, all that prepares for commercial and industrial careers.

There is also a preparatory department attached to this course.

The CLASSICAL COURSE follows the commercial course. It embraces the Greek and Latin Languages, History, Mathematics, Belles - Lettres, Rhetoric, Eloquence, Astronomy, Chemistry, Physics, intellectual and moral Philosophy, and whatever is calculated to prepare for the liberal professions.

The institution is directed by secular priests.

The faculty is composed of priests and ecclesiastics.
