The question of India's position in coming fiscal inquiry was raised by L. Northbrook in the House of Lords on Frid and brought out from Foreign Secret Lansdowne a fuller statement of the government's intentions than had previously be clicited. Lord Lansdowne said India wo certainly be included in the inquiry. To government intended to call ample experience, not only from India but from other parts of the Empire.
