STEEL CORPORATION INTO PARTNERSHIP

New York, Jan. 8.—In accordance with its profit sharing plan of the past nine years, the U. S. Steel Corporation today made known the terms and conditions under which officers and employees of the corporation and its subsidiaries may subscribe for additional preferred and common shares for the current year. The subscription price for the preferred is \$110 and fo the common \$65.

Under this plan employees received \$1,100 or less a year may not subscribe for more than one share of preferred, while those receiving between about \$20,000 and \$34,000 may subscribe for as many as fifteen shares of the common stock. Employees earning under \$500 are limited to one share, with a maximum of 25 shares for the highest priced employees or officials.

Payment of the subscriptions is to be made in monthly installments to be deducted from salaries or from wages. Subscriptions will be received until Feb. 3 next.
