



BY AN ORDER OF THE PRIVY
COUNCIL.

Of the 23rd October, 1868, it is *Ordered*,

That the OFFICE HOURS to be observed by
the Officers, etc., shall be from

9.30 A.M. to 4 P.M.,

except on SUNDAYS and Legal Holidays, and
that on SATURDAYS the hours be from 9.30
A.M. to 1 P.M., except during the Session of
Parliament.

By the 31st Vic., Cap. 1, Sec. 6, it is enacted :

“*Fifteenthly*”—The word “Holiday” shall
include

Sundays.	Corpus Christi.
New Year's Day.	St. Peter and St. Paul's
The Epiphany.	Day.
The Annunciation.	All Saint's Day.
Ash Wednesday.	Conception Day.
Good Friday.	Christmas Day.
Easter Monday.	The Birthday of the
The Ascension.	Reigning Sovereign.

And any day appointed by Proclamation for a
General FAST or THANKSGIVING.
