

CVIII. Any person who shall commit an assault upon the assessors or any of them in the execution of the duties imposed upon them by this Act, shall be deemed guilty of an aggravated assault, and upon being convicted of the offence by any Court of competent jurisdiction 5 upon the oath of the said assessors, or one of them, shall be punished by imprisonment in the Common Gaol of the District, for any period not exceeding months. Assault upon Assessors.

TITLE IX.

General Provisions.

CIX. Within thirty days after the passing of this Act, the Provincial Secretary shall forthwith cause copies thereof to be distributed in 10 each municipality of this Province. Copies of this Act to be distributed.

CX. To each Municipality in Lower Canada, two copies shall be addressed, one in the English and the other in the French language. In what language. In Upper Canada one copy only in English shall be addressed to each Municipality.

15 **CXI.** The said copies shall be addressed to the Mayor or other person discharging the functions of Mayor in each Municipality, and shall be handed over by him to the secretary or clerk of the Municipality for the use of the Municipal Council. To whom to be addressed.

CXII. The Provincial Secretary shall cause the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 20 and 6th titles of this Act to be published three times a month for two language, months in Lower Canada, in one newspaper published in the French and in one newspaper published in the English language, in the cities of Quebec and Montreal, in the languages in which the said newspapers shall be respectively published.
